

BD – Bangladesh

Last update: 08.08.2020

- 1. Visa on arrival suspended for all nationalities.
- 2. Effective on 16.06.2020 at 00:01 BST until further notice:
 - a. All scheduled international commercial passenger flights from Bahrain, Bhutan, Hong Kong, India, Kuwait, Malaysia, Maldives, Nepal, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Singapore, Thailand, Turkey, UAE shall not be allowed to land at any international airport of Bangladesh.
 - b. Helicopter and General Aviation flights may be operated under the following conditions:
 - c. No flight to/from declared lock down areas (areas list yet to be released by government).
 - d. Landing is allowed only at airports and/or designated helipad of the destination District/Upazila; and
 - e. Written / Electronic 'No objection' from the local administration / authority of the aerodrome / helipad shall be obtained and provided to CAAB along with the landing permit application.

MEDEVAC, Humanitarian, and relief flights can be operated without restriction.

- 3. Foreign nationals are required to provide a 'COVID-19 Negative' medical certificate (English translation mandatory) issued within 72 hours before planned arrival.
 - This also applies to Bangladesh origin passengers holding a 'No Visa Required' (NVR). If medical certificate cannot be provided to authority on arrival, passenger will be allowed entering the country subject to 14-day institutionally quarantine. Those holding medical certificate will be required to observe a 14-day home/self-quarantine.
- 4. Landing permit request for MEDEVAC, Humanitarian, Relief, Diplomatic, and Repatriation flights shall be made to the CAAB through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- 5. All other flights not falling into the above restrictions or requirements can be operated as normal.
- 6. Crew rest / layover will be approved subject to the following conditions.
 - No passenger on board. Air crew only.
 - Stay shall not exceed 48 hours
 - Air operator shall provide a complete Crew Layover Plan who shall include as a minimum, but not limited to:
 - a) The carriage of 'COVID-19 Negative" medical certificate by the crew (obtained within 72 hours of the flight);
 - b) Arrangement of transports to hotel (state how the seating arrangement will be planned to maintain physical distance);
 - c) Name of the hotel and address;
 - d) Arrangement for rooms (individual for each crew is appreciated);
 - e) Supply of food for crew (supplied in the room is appreciated);
 - f) Movement plan of the crew outside the room/room (no movement outside room/hotel is appreciated);
 - g) Medical support for the crew (in case of necessity); procedures to be followed for personal protection (PPE or other arrangement);
 - h) Disinfection and sanitization arrangement for the crew;
 - i) Time and arrangement of transports from hotel to airport (state how the seating arrangement will be planned to maintain physical distance);



ID - Indonesia

Last update: 05.08.2020

- 1. Passengers are not allowed to enter and transit.
 - This does not apply to nationals of Indonesia.
 - This does not apply to passengers with a Temporary Stay Permit (ITAS) or Permanent Stay Permit (ITAP).
 - This does not apply to passengers with a diplomatic or a service visa.
 - This does not apply to passengers with a diplomatic or service stay permit.
 - This does not apply to passengers with a visa issued after 31 March 2020.
- 2. Passengers must have a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result issued at most 7 days before arrival. They are subject to quarantine for 14 days.
- 3. Airline crew must have a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result issued at most 7 days before arrival. They are subject to quarantine until their next flight.
- 4. Passengers without a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result are subject to medical screening and quarantine for 14 days.
- 5. Airline crew without a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result are subject to medical screening and quarantine until their next flight.
- 6. Deadhead crew will be given an entry stamp. They must:
 - have a valid crew ID card or crew member certificate;
 - provide written notification to Immigration Officer proving they will be on duty on the return flight. The notification must be received by Immigration Officer minimum 24 hours from arrival.

KH - Cambodia

- 1. VOA, Visa Exemption Policy, Tourist visa and eVisa facilities are suspended until further notice.
 - This does not apply to air crew.
- 2. All passengers, both Cambodian and foreign nationals, must undergo COVID-19 testing upon arrival into the country, at a designated Government COVID-19 testing center. They will be required to remain in the premises until availability of laboratory results and:
 - a) If one or more passengers is tested positive for COVID-19, other accompanying passengers will be subject to a 14-day quarantine at a designated Government facility.
 - b) If all travelers are tested negative, they will be allowed to a 14-day self-isolation at their respective home under supervision of the local authorities and health officials. They will be required to undergo an additional COVID-19 testing, on the 13th day of self-isolation.
 - This does not apply to Air crew.
 - See item 5 for more information on the entry requirements for foreign travelers.
- 3. All air operators must fulfil the following obligations:
 - a) Make copies of foreign travelers' Health Certificate and Health Insurance document to be kept for reference for a period of 20 days so to response to any request by Cambodia competent authorities for cooperation for any investigation.
 - b) Submit to SSCA, one day prior to the flight, at 10:00AM:
 - Purpose of flight
 - Crew Manifest
 - Pax Manifest
 - General Declaration signed by Captain
 - c) Submit to SSCA, after boarding completed at airport of origin, the final total number of passengers, with indication of the airport of origin.
- 4. Effective on 01.08.2020 until further notice: all inbound flights from Malaysia and Indonesia are banned until further notice.
- 5. Effective on 04.08.2020 until further notice: Revision of Entry Requirements for Foreign Travelers See next page.
- 6. Effective on 13.08.2020: all inbound flights from the Philippines are banned until further notice.
- 7. All crew entering Cambodia must stay at one of the designated self-isolation hotels until the result of their COVID test is available. This test is now mandatory on arrival for crew. The result (in form of a written test certificate) does take up to 24 hours, depending on workload at the lab. The verbal result we receive by phone is faster, 6 (during daytime) and up to 12 / 15 hours (if overnight). The crew is not supposed to leave the hotel while waiting for the test result. If the crew has a next schedule, they can depart.

- The hotel booking needs to be done by the operator. Transport to/from the hotel will be provided.
- Payment for the hotel must be made by the crew upon checkout or online while booking.



- A stay in other hotels, before the test result is out, is not permitted.
- The crew must self-isolate at their hotel for 14 days or until their next flight departure, if that is sooner than 14 days.

ANNOUNCEMENT Revision of Entry Requirements for Foreign Travelers to Cambodia

In the purpose of facilitating foreign travelers arriving in Cambodia, and those who are planning to travel to Cambodia, the Ministry of Health (MOH) is honored to announce that the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) will practice Sponsorship Mechanism in order to assist foreign travelers, who are investors-businesspersons, company staffs, experts, skilled workers, technicians and family members, that are sponsored, or invited but not sponsored, or investors without being either sponsored or invited or regular travelers as follows:

- For foreign travelers who are investors-businesspersons, company staffs, experts, skilled workers, technicians and family members, who are sponsored
 - a. Before arriving in Cambodia:
 - Foreign travelers must have the following documents:
 - Medical Certificate issued by health authorities, recognized and certified by the Government of his/her home country indicating that he/she is COVID-19 negative for 72 hours prior to the departure.
 - Validation Certificate on Payment Guarantee which is issued and approved by the RGC. To receive this certificate, the travelers must be sponsored by a chief executive officer or a major shareholder of companies currently operating and well located in Cambodia. The sponsor must request for an online sponsorship, at the RGC's Business Registration website (<u>www.registrationservices.gov.kh</u>) or through URL link posted by the website of the Council for the Development of Cambodia (CDC) (<u>www.cdc.gov.kh</u>) or the website of the MOH (<u>www.cdcmoh.gov.kh</u>). The examination of the validity of the guarantee will take one (1) day to be evaluated and approved by authorized government's entities. Once approved, the RGC will issue the Validation Certificate on Payment Guarantee that can be printed to be used for visa application at Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates, and to be carried while traveling to Cambodia.
 - Valid visa as required by legal procedures listed in the Immigration Law, which has been provided by Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates at the passengers' home country.
 - Letters or documents confirming hotel reservation (Proof of Online Booking) for accommodation, in which the reservation must be made at least three (3) days prior to the departure. The cost of the reservation is the total cost consisting of two-night hotel accommodation, two-day cost of meals, the first COVID-19 medical examination fee, and local transportation cost from the international airport to the hotel. (Note: It is possible that the foreign travelers are required to stay at the reserved hotel for two nights, if the COVID-19 medical examination's result is not yet released) The total cost and hotel options are as follows:
 - Sokha Hotel Phnom Penh: with the total cost of USD385 (USD220 for twonight hotel accommodation, USD60 for two-desengals, USD105 for the first

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COVID-19 medical examination fee, and local transportation cost from the international airport to the hotel).

- b. While arriving at International Airports in Cambodia:
 - b.1: Foreign travelers shall:
 - Present a Valid Visa that was issued by Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates in his/her home country, a Medical Certificate issued by health authorities, recognized and certified by the Government of his/her home country indicating that he/she is COVID-19 negative for 72 hours prior to the departure, a Validation Certificate on Payment Guarantee, and Letters or Documents confirming hotel reservation (Proof of Online Booking)
 - Have the right to use Special Priority Lane, after having the above-mentioned required documents inspected, to receive the COVID-19 medical examination, facilitated by health officials before being transported to the reserved hotels.

b.2: In the event that the foreign travelers have to be quarantined for 14 days, the sponsor must be responsible for all expenses. The sponsor is required to:

- Pay in full to the hotel for all expenses based on the actual invoice, for the 14-day hotel accommodation expenses, within the 7-day stay.
- Pay to the MOH for the fees of the following-up COVID-19 medical examination tests at the end of the 14-day quarantine period.

b.3: In the event that the foreign travelers have contracted the COVID-19 virus during their stay in Cambodia, the sponsor is required to cover all medical expenses until the patient is fully recovered, and to pay to the public hospital where the patient has been admitted for treatment. B.4: The sponsor must be responsible in front of the laws, and provide full cooperation with the MOH in facilitating the travels of the sponsored travelers.

II. For foreign travelers who are investors-businesspersons, company staffs, experts, skilled workers, technicians and family members, who have not been sponsored but invited:

- a. Before arriving in Cambodia:
 - Foreign travelers shall have the following documents:
 - Medical Certificate issued by health authorities, recognized and certified by the Government of his/her home country indicating that he/she is COVID-19 negative for 72 hours prior to the departure.
 - Validation Certificate of Invitation which is issued and approved by the RGC. To
 receive this certificate, the travelers must be invited by a chief executive officer or a
 major shareholder of companies currently operating and were brated in Cambodia. The

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inviter shall request for an online invitation, at the RGC's Business Registration website (<u>www.registrationservices.gov.kh</u>) or through URL link posted by the website of the Council for the Development of Cambodia (<u>www.cdc.gov.kh</u>) or the website of the MOH (<u>www.cdcmoh.gov.kh</u>). After examining the validity of the invitation which will take one (1) day, the RGC will issue the Validation Certificate of the Invitation that can be printed to be used for visa application at Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates, and to be carried while traveling to Cambodia

- Valid visa as required by legal procedures listed in the Immigration Law, which has been provided by Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates at the travelers' home country.
- Proof of Health Insurance package for COVID-19 treatment purchased by travelers, with a cost of USD90 and is valid for 20 days. This insurance package can be purchased from FORTE Insurance Company that can be reached through: https://www.forteinsurance.com/covid-19-insurance/
- Letters or documents confirming hotel reservation (Proof of Online Booking) for accommodation, in which the reservation must be made at least three (3) days prior to the departure. The cost of the reservation is the total cost consisting of two-night hotel accommodation, two-day cost of meals, the first COVID-19 medical examination fee, and local transportation cost from the international airport to the reserved hotel. (Note: It is possible that the foreign travelers are required to stay at the reserved hotel for two nights, if the COVID-19 medical examination's result is not yet released) The total cost and hotel options are as follows:

b. When arriving at International Airports in Cambodia:

Foreign travelers shall:

 Present a Valid Visa that was issued by Royal Cambodian Embassies or Consulates in his/her home country, a Medical Certificate issued by health authorities, recognized and certified by the Government of his/her home country indicating that he/she is COVID-19 negative for 72 hours prior to the departure, a Validation Certificate of Invitation, a Proof of Health Insurance package, and Letters of Decompany confirming hotel reservation (Proof of Online Booking)

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- Deposit USD2,000 to cover hotel accommodation costs while waiting for COVID-19
 test result, medical examination fees, local transportation cost from the international
 airport to reserved hotel and expenses during quarantine period, in the case that any
 fellow travelers are tested positive for COVID-19
- Have the right to use Special Priority Lane, after having the above-mentioned required documents inspected, to receive the COVID-19 medical examination, facilitated by health officials before being transported to the reserved hotels.

III. For foreign travelers who are investors-businesspersons, company staffs, experts, skilled workers, technicians and family members, without being either sponsored or invited:

Cambodia will warmly welcome the arrival of foreign travellers who are investorsbusinesspersons, company staffs, experts, skilled workers, technicians and family members without being either sponsored or invited. They are required to follow the same rules and procedures as other regular foreign travellers stated in Point IV below.

IV. Other regular foreign travelers planning to travel to Cambodia shall:

a. Comply with the Announcement No. 564 issued on 11 June 2020 by the MOH on the service fees for COVID-19 medical examination, quarantine, and COVID-19 treatment at public hospitals which is still in effect.

b. Deposit USD2,000 upon arrival at international airports in Cambodia, which will be used to cover hotel accommodation costs while waiting for COVID-19 test result, medical examination fees, local transportation cost from the international airport to the reserved hotel and expenses during quarantine period, in the case that any fellow travelers are tested positive for COVID-19

c. Purchase a health insurance package for COVID-19 treatment, with a cost of USD90 and is valid for 20 days. This insurance package can be purchased from FORTE Insurance Company that can be reached through: <u>https://www.forteinsurance.com/covid-19-insurance/</u>

V. All travelers as stated in Section I, II, III and IV who have entered Cambodia shall be tested for the COVID-19 virus in accordance with the health guidelines, at local public health centers.

As informed above, foreign travelers who are investors-businesspersons, company employees, experts, skilled workers, technicians, family members and other foreign travelers, should be fully aware and responsibly cooperate to effectively implement measures against COVID-19, issued by the Inter-Ministerial Commission to Eight Against OVID-19 from the date of public release of this announcement.



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LA - Laos

- 1. All types of visa are suspended until further notice.
 - Exceptions are made to some categories of travelers See item 4.
- 2. Suspension of all international scheduled and non-scheduled flight until 31.08.2020. This does not apply to the following flights. Prior approval from Ministry of Foreign Affairs is required.
 - Diplomatic/Government/Military (to be processed via Diplomatic channel)
 - Cargo
 - Humanitarian
 - Medevac
 - Repatriate
 - Diplomatic
- 3. Domestic flight operations are allowed in accordance with relevant approvals.

Notice (No.10)

To: All Parties Concerned.

Subject: Extension for the suspension of international flights entering into Lao PDR effective from 01st to 31st August 2020.

- According to the Ministerial Decision on Roles and Functions of Department of Civil Aviation, No. 18999/MPWT, dated 08 August 2019;
- Pursuant to the Prime Minister's Order, No. 06/PM, dated 29 March 2020;
- Pursuant to the Prime Minister Office's Order, No. 697/PMO, dated 30th June 2020;
- Pursuant to the Prime Minister Office's Order, No. 806/PMO dated 29th July 2020;
- According to the Notice on Travel Advisory for Entering and Exiting Lao PDR during the Implementation of Measures to prevent, control and respond COVID-19 Pandemic, No. 1861/MoFA.TF, dated 31st July 2020.

The Pandemic of Coronavirus (COVID-19) globally is continued to increase. In Lao PDR the pandemic is continued to be the risk and challenge. Thus, the Prime Minister Office had issued the Letter No. 697/PMO dated 30th June 2020 on the extension to the restrictions under the Prime Minister Oder, No. 06/PM, dated 29 March 2020 and the extension of the Prime Minister Office Letter No. 806/PMO, dated 29th July 2020. The Department of Civil Aviation of Laos (DCA) is pleased to notify you that the suspension of <u>all International commercial scheduled and non-scheduled passenger flights entered to Lao PDR have been extended for 31 Days from 01st August 2020 at 00.00 Hours until the 31st August 2020 at 24.00 Hours or until further notice. In addition, domestic flight operations are allowed in accordance with relevant approvals.</u>

The exception is made to the commercial cargo, air medevac, humanitarian, relief, diplomat and repatriation flights, provided that the request shall be submitted to Task Force Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Lao PDR through the diplomatic channel for further entry permit. The exception is applicable to the emergency landing and technical stop for refueling with no disembarkation of crews and passengers. If disembarkation is requested, the aircraft will be assigned at the designated and isolated parking spot and preventive instructions imposed by relevant airport health authorities shall be strictly performed.

All types of visa are suspended except for the following:

I. Prior to the departure to the Lao PDR

- A diplomatic mission and international organization with an essential and urgent need to bring in its diplomats or staffs to carry out its duties both on a short or long term can do so by proposing in writing to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
- Any Ministry and Agency with an essential and urgent need to bring in experts and foreign students can do so by proposed in writing to the Task Force Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; <u>A</u>

- Companies or project owners in Lao PDR with an urgent need to bring in foreign workers and technicians for their large investment projects can do so in consistence with relevant requirements. First, they have to follow the normal procedures as required under the relevant law and regulations for bringing in foreign workers by submitting a proposal in writing to the Task Force Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with details on full name, anticipated travel date, mode of transportation, point of entry, quarantine hotel or facility or residence, country(s) of transit or connecting flights, if any and reasons why it is so urgent;
- Lao nationals who wish to return to Lao PDR, they need to register at the Lao embassy or consulate general at the country of their residence and provide necessary information (why he/she has been stranded, date, time and point of entry, etc.) for consideration and facilitation by the latter.
- Any application for entry into Lao PDR shall be submitted to the Task Force Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at least 7 days prior the date of entry into the Lao PDR.

After receiving authorization from Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA):

- Any individual with valid entry visa can enter Lao PDR provided that he/she must obtain an authorization in writing from the Task Force Committee of Ministry of Foreign Affairs prior entry into the Lao PDR;
- Upon receipt of written authorization in relation to a proper visa type, any individual who does
 not have a valid entry visa to Lao PDR must apply for a visa at the nearest Lao Embassy or
 Consulate General at the country of departure;
- Every individual must have a negative test for COVID-19 certification using RT-PCR from a trustworthy medical institution by means of endorsing from the competent authority such as Ministry of Public Health which has been issued no more than 72 hours prior departure to Lao PDR.

II. On arrival at a border checkpoint or airport

- Every Individual must go through a body temperature check;
- Duly complete a health declaration form;
- In case of an individual found to have fever or suspicious symptoms of COVID-19, he/she will be directly sent to designated hospitals for quarantine and COVID-19 testing;
- In case of no fever or suspicious symptoms of COVID-19, he/she will be recommended to
 perform self-quarantine at a government designated facility and taken COVID-19 testing;
- Check in at immigration counter as required by the law and regulations with maintaining physical distancing of 1-2 meters.

III. After entering the Lao PDR

- Every individual will be subject to take samples for COVID-19 testing;
- Every individual is subject to a strict 14-days self-quarantine at a hotel or centre designated by the Task Force Committees at the central and local levels;
- For diplomats, staffs of international organizations and their family members travelling from abroad, they are required to undergo COVID-19 testing upon arrival at the Government-designated Hospitals and after that they can perform a 14-days self-quarantine at their residence or at a hotel designated by the Government. For those who are residing in Lao PDR but need to travel out of the country for a short period, they can do so by notifying the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in advance and upon returning to Lao PDR they have to make self-quarantine at their residence and strictly follow the advice by the Ministry of Health for self-quarantine;
- Every individual who practices a 14-days self-quarantine at the hotel designated by the Task Force Committee shall bear all expenses on food, room and other accidental cost.
- After completion of a 14-days self-quarantine without any symptoms of COVID-19 infection, the individual will receive a certificate for him/her to stay at their home and live their normal lives,

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but they also must continue to strictly implement the prevention measures as advised by the Task Force Committee;

 Any individual who violates the prevention measures as provided by the Task Force Committee for COVID-19 will be prosecuted according to the law and regulations of the Lao PDR.

IV. Departing the Lao PDR

- Lao nationals who have an essential and urgent need to travel overseas shall be subject the
 relevant approval from their respective organizations and the application subsequently must be
 submitted to Task Force Committee of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for further assistance and
 facilitation. In addition, relevant regulations and laws of destined country must be applied at all
 time;
- Lao Nationals or foreign citizens who may be more likely to have severe illness and need a regular medical treatment (severe diseases that could not be treated at any hospitals in Lao PDR) in urgent needs to travel overseas for such medical treatment reasons, shall apply for Medical Certificate from any government hospital or valid Medical Appointment Certificate from a respective hospital in a destined country. In addition, relevant regulations and laws of destined country must be applied at all time;
- Foreign citizens who wish to depart the Lao PDR shall contact their respective embassy or general consulate to the Lao PDR. The application for departing Lao PDR in writing shall be submitted to Task Force Committee of Ministry of Foreign Affairs, The necessary information provided must include name list, passport numbers, anticipated travel dates, port of departure, mode of transportation for further consideration and facilitation assistance.

MM - Myanmar

1. Visa on Arrival (VOA) and e-Visa facilities are suspended for all nationalities until **31.08.2020.**

This is applicable to air crew.

Diplomats, UN Officials and any foreign national who intends to travel to Myanmar shall contact the nearest Myanmar missions for necessary entry visa or ease of quarantine procedures.

- 2. Nationals of China are not allowed to transit Myanmar without a visa.
- 3. From 25.03.2020 at 00:01 MM LT to **31.08.2020.**
 - All incoming Myanmar nationals from any country will be subject to a 14-day facility quarantine on their arrival in Myanmar.
 - All foreign nationals traveling to Myanmar are required to present laboratory evidence of absence of COVID-19 infection issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel before boarding any airlines destined for Myanmar. They will be subject to a 14-day facility quarantine on their arrival in Myanmar.
 - All diplomats accredited to Myanmar and United Nations officials working in Myanmar are also required to
 present laboratory evidence of absence of COVID-19 infection issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date
 of travel before boarding any airline destined for Myanmar. They will be subject to home quarantine for 14
 days on their arrival in Myanmar.
- 4. All passengers and Air Crew entering Myanmar are required to fill in a Health Declaration Card.
- 5. Any foreign national with valid entry visa may enter and exit to/from Myanmar only at Yangon, Mandalay and Nay Pyi Taw International Airports in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.
- 6. From 30.03.2020 at 23:59 MM LT to **31.08.2020**:
 - All internationals commercial passenger flights are not allowed to land at any airport.
 - All landing permissions previously granted by MM DCA are suspended.

This does not apply to Relief flights, Cargo flights, Ambulance flights and special flights but these flight s shall be specifically approved by local authority.

This does not apply to technical stop with quick turnaround. Landing permit application for this type of flight can be processed as usual.

Crew member may be subject to quarantine until next departure schedule.

7. Nationwide Curfew in force from 00:00 LT (1730Z) to 04:00 LT (2130Z).

In order to enable airport workers to make their journeys to/from home before curfew time, operators shall flight plan with respect of below requirements.

Arriving aircrafts:

- Ground Handling operations shall be completed by 1530Z.
- Earliest Arrival shall not be earlier than 2300Z
- Latest Arrival shall not be later than 1415Z

Departing Aircraft:

• Handling operations cannot start before 2300Z.



- Earliest Departure shall not be earlier than 2330Z.
- Latest Departure shall not be later than 1530Z.
- 8. ENR ATS are working as normal and air operators can fill VYYY as alternate aerodrome.



MY - Malaysia

Last update: 31.07.2020

- 1. Aircraft Entry / Transit / Exit
 - a. All international inbound flight must plan WMKK as point of entry.
 - b. Night stop flight allowed at WMKK only, and subject to approval from Immigration Authority.
 - c. Transit: allowed at WMKK only, and subject to approval from Immigration Authority.
- 2. Passenger Entry / Transit / Exit
 - a. All passenger eligible for entering the country (nationals and residents) are required to download and register on the <u>MySejahtera</u> App.
 - b. Foreign nationals already in the country can exit with no restriction.
 - c. Foreign nationals are restricted from entry to Malaysia until August 31, though this end date may be change at the discretion of the Malaysian government.
 - d. All national and foreign passengers are allowed to transit through WMKK with no restriction.
 - e. Malaysian citizens with a foreign residence permit, are allowed to depart with Immigration Authority approval. Please email to:

- f. Quarantine requirements: See Government Guidelines.
- 3. Air Crew Entry / Transit / Exit
 - a. Allowed entering Malaysia through WMKK only, subject to approval from Immigration Authority.
 - b. Must observe self-isolation at the hotel until next departure schedule.
 - c. Transit: no restrictions if not entering the country.
- 4. All visitors are required to fill up a health declaration form before entering the country. If they have visited or stayed in affected countries over the past fourteen (14) days, they must declare health status on the form.
- 5. Regional Regulatory Requirements
 - a. West Malaysia: Domestic flight allowed only. No special approval required.
 - b. East Malaysia Sabah: COVID-19 lab test certificate issued within 72 hours before planned arrival is mandatory.
 - c. East Malaysia Sarawak: To submit E-health declaration form +12 hours before planned arrival.
- 6. WMSA / SZB: Air Crew Entry/Exit Regulations
 - a) Cockpit and Cabin crew of Malaysian nationality:
 - Exit: No exit approval required from Immigration Authority.
 - Entry: No Covid-19 testing and quarantine required.
 - b) Flight Engineer of Malaysian Nationality:
 - Entry: Covid-19 testing undergone less than 72 hours before arrival and home-quarantine are required.
 - Exit: No exit approval required from Immigration Authority.
 - c) Foreign Cockpit and Cabin Crew:



- No longer required to obtain entry & exit approval from Immigration Authority.
- No Covid-19 testing and quarantine required when entering via WMSA.
- d) Foreign Flight Engineer
 - No longer required to obtain entry & exit approval from Immigration Authority.
 - Covid-19 testing undergone less than 72 hours before arrival and hotel quarantine are required.

Note: COVID-19 testing facility is available at WMSA. Testing can be undergone upon arrival.



PG – Papua New Guinea

- 1. State of Emergency declared from 24.03.2020 to 15.08.2020
- 2. All international travelers are not allowed to enter the country, unless authorized by Ministry of Health. A special exemption shall be submitted to the relevant authority.
 - This is also applicable to Air Crew, Nationals and Residents.
- 3. All international and domestic flights are suspended, and landing permits must be approved by the state of emergency authorities, including ambulance flights.
 - This is also applicable to Ambulance flight.
- 4. All incoming nationals shall go through a 14 days quarantine before they can be released into the community.



TH – Thailand

Last update: 29.07.2020

- 1. State of Emergency extended till 31.08.2020
- 2. The following aircraft will be allowed to fly over, fly into or out of, and take-off from or land at an international airport in the Kingdom when permit is given by the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand:
 - (1) State or military aircraft
 - (2) Emergency landing flights
 - (3) Technical landing flights without disembarkation
 - (4) Humanitarian aid, medical and relief flights
 - (5) Repatriation flights
 - (6) Cargo flights
- 3. Permit for passenger aircraft will be given by the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand for flying over, flying into or out of, and taking off or landing at an international airport in the Kingdom only if the passengers or persons on board are one of the following categories:

(1) Thai nationals

(2) Persons with exemption or persons being considered, permitted or invited by the Prime Minister, or the head of responsible persons accountable for resolving state of emergency issues to enter the Kingdom, as necessary. Such consideration, permission or invitation may be subject to specified conditions and time limits.

(3) Non-Thai nationals who are a spouse, parents, or children of a Thai national.

(4) Non-Thai nationals with a certificate of permanent residency, including their spouses and children

(5) Non-Thai nationals who hold a valid work permit or are allowed to work in the Kingdom, including their spouse or children.

(6) Carriers of necessary goods, subject to immediate return after completion.

(7) Crew members who are required to travel into the Kingdom on a mission and have a specified date and time for return.

(8) Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational institutions approved by Thai authorities, including the parents or guardians of the students.

(9) Non-Thai nationals who are in need of medical treatment in Thailand, and their attendants. However, this shall not include medical treatment for COVID–19.

(10) Individuals in diplomatic missions, consular affairs, international organizations, government representatives, foreign government agencies working in Thailand, or individual in other international agencies as permitted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, including their spouse, parents, or children. (11) Non-Thai nationals who are permitted to enter the Kingdom under a special arrangement with a foreign country.

4. Aircraft and passengers or persons entering the Kingdom under No. 2 must comply with the conditions, time limits and rules of the authorized persons under the Thai immigration law, communicable diseases' law, air navigation law, and the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation in force, for prevention of the disease and the organization of the number of persons entering Thailand in accordance with the screening capability of the competent officers or the communicable disease control officers, and the arrangement of quarantine facilities.

TH Airport Restrictions

VTSP/KHT – Phuket

1. From 09.04.2020 at 17:01 UTC to 31.08.2020 at 17:00 UTC: Airport closed to inbound flights.

This does not apply to:



- Ambulance
- State / Military
- Technical landing (direct turnaround only with no pax disembarking)
- Humanitarian and Relief
- Repatriation
- Cargo

VTBD/DMK – Don Muang

1. From 31.03.2020 until further notice, airport slot request will be considered on a case-by-case basis and may take up to 7 days to be approved.

VTBU/UTP – U-Tapao

- 1. Air Crew are required to fill out the T8 form before arrival and present it to Immigration officer on arrival.
- 2. All aircrafts shall undergo deep cleaning and disinfection on arrival. An 'Aircraft Cleaning and Disinfection' certificate shall be issued by an accredited aircraft cleaning and disinfection provider. This certificate is to be presented to Health Authority.
- 3. Air Crew are required to fill out the "Form for Accepting to Follow the Regulations" for stay over 24 hours.
- 4. Air Crew must download the "AOT Airports" mobile application and enter the required information.
- 5. Air Crew must remain at their hotel until next departure schedule.
- 6. Airport Parking Slot:
 - Operators shall strictly comply with the slot time approved by authority.
 - Any request for airport slot extension shall be submitted to the airport slot board with a prior notice of 24 hours. This must be supported by a letter from Operator stating the reason, along with any evidence that could justify such extension.

In the case of failure to comply with above obligations, the airport slot board reserves the right to ban operator from operating to the airport.

Aircraft in violation with these obligations will be moved to an unmonitored remote area. Operator shall be responsible for any damage that may occur while parked on this area.

VTSM/USM – Samui

From 07.04.2020 to 31.08.2020, airport will be partially closed. The following flights only will be accepted.

- 1. Ambulance/Medical flight
- Ferry non-scheduled flight with domestic origin, to pick-up pax only. Scheduled ground time shall not exceed 60 minutes. Crew shall remain on board. Pax not travelling to their country of nationality shall present a certificate of residence of the country of destination.
- 3. If passenger travelling to either VTBD or VTBS to connecting on a schedule flight, the airline flight number shall be advised upon application of landing permissions.



VN – Vietnam

Last update: 08.08.2020

- 1. All visa issuances are suspended.
 - Nationals of Italy and Korea (Rep.) with a normal passport are no longer visa exempt.
 - Nationals of Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Norway, Spain, Sweden and passengers with a British passport are no longer visa exempt.
- 2. Passengers are not allowed to enter Vietnam.
 - This does not apply to passengers on diplomatic or official duty. They will be subject to mandatory medical declaration and self-isolation.
 - This does not apply to passengers who are experts, business managers or highly skilled workers. They must show a COVID-19 negative medical certificate issued no more than 7 days before the planned entry into the country and will be subject to mandatory medical declaration and self-isolation.
 - This does not apply to passengers approved by National Steering Committee on Covid-19 Prevention and Control.
 - This does not apply to passenger holding APEC card with VN mentioned at the back. They can enter the territory for a stay of maximum 90 days.
 - ► All passengers must fill out a quarantine form prior to arrival.
 - ► All passengers must wear face masks during the flight and when entering the airport
 - ► All passengers will be placed on quarantine at a designated facility for 14 days upon arrival.

► Foreign nationals need embassy-issued visas in advance (visa on arrival issuance and visa-free entry is suspended) and an approval letter from the Vietnamese Government that they are approved to enter Vietnam. A copy of this letter needs to be submitted by the handling agent to CAAV when applying for the landing permit.

- 3. Air Crew:
 - With a prior approval required from authority of 02 working days, Holders of APEC cards with VN mentioned on the back of the card can enter Vietnam without visa but subject to the following conditions.
 - Allowed entering Vietnam via VVNB/HAN or VVDN/DAD only.
 - Must observe quarantine until next departure schedule in designated hotels (Crowne Plaza, Intercontinental, Daewoo).
 - Must fill out a quarantine form prior to arrival
 - Must show COVID-19 negative medical certificate issued no more than 72 hours prior to arrival
 - Quick turnaround: No visa required if they depart immediately after passenger drop-off/pick-up.
- 4. Vietnamese national shall contact the Vietnam Embassy in their guest country to apply for a return permission to Vietnam. If approved, they will receive an approval letter to be submitted along with the landing permit application to CAAV.
- 5. VVDN / DAD: From 28.07.2020 to 13.08.2020, all inbound and outbound flights are suspended.
- 6. VVNB / HAN: From 10.08.2020 to 15.05.2021, airport closed daily from 17:30 to 22:30 UTC.
